*Foresters from the private sector and the Indiana DNR will be on hand to answer any questions you may have.*

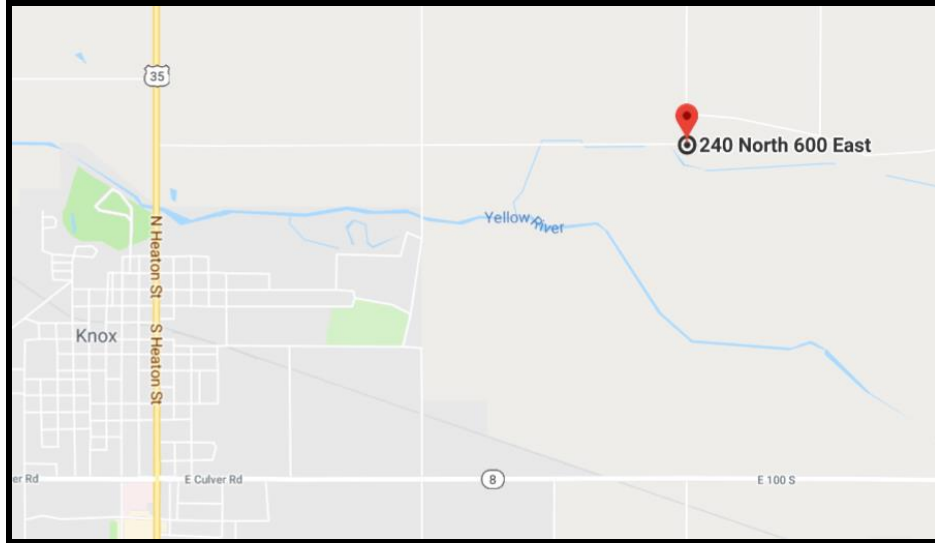
